

JULY 9, 1952

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Recessed Session July 9th, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Johnson, Rogers, and Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney; Claude R. Black, City Engineer.

The minutes of the Meetings held on June 23rd, 30th and July 4th, were read and approved.

At this time, George Peterson appeared before the Council representing citizens residing on 17th, who were protesting the 17th Street underpass and highway; petition filed and signed by 108 citizens. Mr. Tway appeared before the Council asking that the proposed paving of 9th Street, between Wabash and Division Streets, be omitted. Mr. Muncey protested the proposed paving of Crowley Street, from Ada to Rappleye Addition. The above protests were referred to the City Engineer.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Rogers, that the Continental Oil Co., be permitted to make a 92' curb cut on Elm Street and Water Avenue. On roll call, voting Aye, 4. Nay, None. Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the Continental Oil Company be allowed to make curb cuts at First and Holmes with the approval of the City Engineer. On roll call, voting Aye, 4. Nay, None. Carried.

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho, met in a Regular Adjourned Meeting on Wednesday the 9th day of July, 1952, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the City Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho; due and legal notice of said Meeting having been given as required by law and the rules and ordinances of the City.

On motion of Councilman Foote, seconded by Councilman Freeman, the following Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Council and the Mayor:

“RESOLVED: THAT THE ACTUAL VALUE OF THE REAL PROPERTY INCLUDED IN PROPOSED LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 22 IS \$2,785,464.00; THAT THE ACTUAL VALUE OF THE REAL PROPERTY INCLUDED IN SAID DISTRICT, EXCLUSIVE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS THEREON IS \$928,728.00; THAT SEVERAL PROTESTS AGAINST PORTIONS OF THE PROPOSED WORK HAVE BEEN MADE IN WRITING BY PROPERTY OWNERS AND FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK; THAT SUCH PROTESTS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE OWNERS OF LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE ABUTTING, ADJOINING, CONTIGUOUS AND ADJACENT LOTS AND LANDS WITHIN SUCH PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; THAT EACH AND ALL OF SAID PROTESTS HAVE BEEN CAREFULLY CONSIDERED; THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY IS INCLUDED WITHIN SAID DISTRICT WHICH SHOULD NOT BE ASSESSED TO PAY THE COSTS AND EXPENSES OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT, AND THAT PORTIONS OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT SHOULD NOT BE MADE, AND THE SAME MAY BE ELIMINATED FROM THE DISTRICT; THAT THE PETITION REQUESTING THE ORGANIZATION OF THE DISTRICT IS PROPER AND THE DISTRICT, AFTER SUCH PORTIONS ARE ELIMINATED THERE FROM, WILL BE FOR THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE PROPERTY AFFECTED AND THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, THAT THERE IS REASONABLE PROBABILITY THAT THE OBLIGATIONS OF SUCH DISTRICT, AS MODIFIED, WILL BE PAID; THAT THE RESOLUTION OF INTENTION PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON JUNE 18TH, 1952, SHALL BE AND THE SAME HEREBY IS, AMENDED AND MODIFIED AS TO THE STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS AND ALLEYS AND PARTS OF ALLEYS AND LOTS AND LANDS TO BE INCLUDED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 22, TO READ AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

STREET PAVING IN BRODBECK ADDITION

Emerson Avenue: from the north side of 23rd Street to the south side of 24th Street.
Higbee Avenue: from the south side of 21st Street to the south side of 23rd Street.
