Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Special Session on June 30, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers for the purpose of hearing and considering protests against creating Local Improvement District No. 22. There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman & Foote. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Arthur Smith, City Attorney; Claude Black, City Engineer. Absent: Councilmen Johnson, Rogers.

The Mayor explained the purpose of the Meeting and that the Meeting was now open to hear protests against the creation of L. I. D. No. 22.

Several written protests were received and oral protests were heard.

The protests were referred to the Street Committee and the City Engineer for study and investigation.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Foote, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
