Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in a Special Session on May 12, 1952, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers. For the purpose of opening sealed bids for the construction of pump house on Lots 45, 46, 47, and 48 of Block 30, South Park Addition, also, to consider U.P.R.R. Co., for changes in Railroad Co. signal and telegraph lines near Municipal Airport. There being present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Foote and Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk, Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney and C. R. Black, City Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the date set for opening of bids for the construction of pump house. The bids were opened and read as follows, to-wit:

The above bids were referred to the Council, Building Inspector, and City Engineer for consideration.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Rogers, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign contract with the Union Pacific R. R. Co., L.D. No. 15189, changes in R. R. signal and telegraph lines near Airport. On roll call, voting Aye, 2. Nay, None. Carried. Absent Johnson and Freeman.
