The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session November 16, 1951, at 8 P.M. in the Council Chambers of Idaho Falls, Idaho. There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Johnson, Freeman, Foote and Rogers. Also present: S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; and Art Smith, City Attorney.

The minutes of a Meeting held on November 8, 1951, were read and approved.

The monthly report for the month of October from Drs. Graves and Eater, meat inspection, was read by the Clerk. There being no objections, the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

ORDINANCE NO. 783

ELECTRICITY THEREIN WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The above Ordinance was read by the Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Rogers that the above Ordinance be adopted and passed on its third and final reading. On roll call voting Aye, 4. Nay, None. Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Rogers authorizing publishing of notice to contractors for sealed bids on equipment for auditorium to be published on November 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> and December 3, 1951. On roll call voting Aye, 4. Nay, None. Carried.

The Police Committee recommended the purchases of new automobiles for the Police Department. The Mayor referred the purchase of new automobiles to the Police Committee with power to act.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Freeman that the Mayor is hereby authorized to appoint an Auditor to check the accounts, get inventory of equipment, check all deeds and mortgages and etc., belonging to the Fielding Memorial Cemetery, to determine the exact status of assets and liabilities belonging to the Cemetery. On roll call voting Aye, 4. Nay, None. Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Johnson that the City Attorney be instructed to start condemnation proceedings against the Texas Company, to secure right-of-way for the improvement of the North Yellowstone Ave., at N. Blvd. and First Street. On roll call voting Aye, 4. Nay, None. Carried.

It was moved by Councilman Johnson and seconded by Rogers that the Council adjourn. Carried unanimously.
