

OCTOBER 12, 1951

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Special Session on October 12, 1951, at 2 P.M. for the purpose of making a canvass of the election results of the Special Municipal Coupon Bond Election, held on Tuesday, October 9, 1951. There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Foote, Rogers and Johnson; S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; and Arthur Smith, City Attorney.

The Meeting was called to order, Mayor E. W. Fanning presiding.

Councilman Johnson moved that the City Council resolve itself into a Canvassing Board to canvass the returns of the Special Bond Election held in said City on Tuesday, the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1951. The motion was seconded by Councilman Rogers and was carried by the unanimous vote of all Councilmen present.

Said City Council immediately resolved itself into a Canvassing Board, and the Clerk having produced the returns, the Board proceeded to open and canvass the votes in the manner required by law.

After completing the canvass of the votes cast in the matter of the issuance of Municipal Coupon Bonds in the amount of \$255,000, to provide funds for the purpose of constructing and equipping a public building to be used for auditorium and other municipal purposes, and to acquire a site therefore, the Board found the returns to be regular and in all respects made in the manner and form required by law, and thereupon made an abstract of the votes cast at said Special Election, which said abstract was in wards and figures as follows, to-wit:

Thereupon it was moved by Councilman Foote and seconded by Councilman Johnson that the City Council resume its regular order of business, which motion was carried by the unanimous vote of all Councilmen present, and the City Council thereupon resumed the regular order of business.

Thereupon, Councilman Rogers introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**RESOLUTION**

“RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULT OF A CANVASS OF THE VOTES CAST AT THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, ON OCTOBER 9, 1951, ON THE QUESTION OF ISSUING MUNICIPAL COUPON BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$255,000.”

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, at a Special Meeting thereof, duly and regularly held as required by law on Friday, the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1951, did publicly open the returns and canvass the votes of the Special Bond Election held in the

four municipal wards thereof on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1951, to vote on the question of issuing Municipal Coupon Bonds in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Dollars (\$255,000), to provide funds for the purpose of constructing and equipping a public building to be used for auditorium and other municipal purposes, and to acquire a site therefore.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO:

**Section 1.** That it is hereby declared that the result of the canvas of the votes of the Special Bond Election held in the City of Idaho Falls, in the four municipal wards thereof, on Tuesday, the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1951, as follows:

In favor of issuing bonds in the amount of \$255,000	999
Against issuing bonds in the amount of \$255,000	331
Total vote cast in entire City in the four municipal wards thereof	1330

**Section 2.** That the said question so voted upon at said Special Bond Election is hereby declared to have been duly carried by more than two-thirds (2/3) vote of the qualified electors who are taxpayers in said City in the four municipal wards thereof, voting at said election, and that the right and power was given to said City to issue bonds in the amount of \$255,000.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

Councilman Johnson seconded by adoption of the foregoing resolution and the same on being put to a vote was unanimously carried by the affirmative vote of all Councilmen present, the vote being as follows:
