

JULY 31, 1951

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Special Session July 31, 1951, at 1:30 P.M. for the purpose of considering construction detail regarding South Bel-Aire and Hillcrest Additions; and the approval of license applications for the operating of coin-operated amusement devices, (slot machines). There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Johnson, Rogers and Foote; S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; Claude Black, City Engineer.

It was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Johnson that the sidewalks in South Bel-Aire Addition, be placed next to curbing, (no parking strip between curb and sidewalk) on all streets abutting 36' paving. On all streets with 30' paving, sidewalks to be placed on property line. On roll call voting Aye, 4. Nay, None.

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Johnson that the streets in lower Hillcrest Addition be completed as per City specifications with 3/8 " chips. On roll call voting Aye, 4. Nay, None.

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Foote, that the above license applications be approved and licenses issued for the 5 month period, August 1, to December 31, 1951.
