

APRIL 6, 1951

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho met in Regular Session April 6, 1951, at 8:00 P.M. There being present: Councilmen Russell A. Freeman, John Rogers, and Ross Corbett. Mayor Sutton and Councilman Vernon S. Johnson were absent. Mr. Freeman, president of the Council, conducted the Meeting.

The minutes of the Meeting of March 16th, and two Special Meetings, March 21st, and April 4th, were read by the Clerk after which it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Rogers that the minutes be approved. Roll call voting Aye, 3. Voting Nay, None.

The bills for the month of March, having been audited by the Finance Committee, were recommended for payment as follows:

The resignation of Joseph F. Charboneau was read by the Clerk and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Rogers that the resignation be accepted and that a resolution be included in the

minutes thanking Mr. Charboneau for his fine work and the efforts that he has put forth while acting as Chief of Police of the City. Roll call voting Aye, 3. Voting Nay, None.

RESOLUTION

“Mayor Fanning and Council”

I suggest that a resolution be adopted at this meeting commending our fellow citizen, Thomas L. Sutton, for his long service of 16 years on the City Council, and his two years as our Mayor.

It was moved by Freeman and seconded by Corbett that the foregoing resolution be adopted. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers. Voting Nay, None.

At this time Mayor Fanning stated that in as much as there was not a full Council present he would not make any Committee appointments and asked that the Councilmen continue to act in the same capacities that they had been in the past. The Department heads and foremen of the various Departments were advised that no radical changes were to be made and Mr. Fanning stated that he would move slowly, and should any changes be decided upon the personal affected would be advised in advance.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the Mayor ordered the Meeting adjourned.
