

FEBRUARY 6, 1951

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho met in Regular Session February 6, 1951, in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls. There were present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Councilmen Rogers, Freeman, and Corbett. Councilman Johnson being absent. Also present: E. A. Owen, City Attorney; Charles H. Williams, City Clerk.

The minutes of the Meetings held January 5th and 19th, were read and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Rogers that the minutes be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers.

At this time the Mayor asked the Council to approve the appointment of Hy Hansen, Ray R. Moore, A. D. Hill, Eldon Jacobsen, and Luke Walker to the Electrical Examining Board of the City. It was moved by Rogers and seconded by Corbett, that the above appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers. Voting Nay, None.

The Finance Committee having audited the bills for the previous months expense recommended payment of the following:

The monthly reports of the various City Departments were read by the Clerk after which it was moved by Rogers and seconded by Freeman that the reports be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Freeman, and Corbett. Voting Nay, None.

A statement which had been sent to Ben Brothers for damage to the power line was presented with a check from the insurance company in the amount of \$29.40 being part payment of the account. The total of the statement was \$54.40. After due discussion and consideration by the Mayor and Councilmen it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Corbett that the check be accepted in full payment of the account. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers. Voting Nay, None.

It was moved by Freeman and seconded by Corbett that the renewal be granted and the Mayor authorized to sign the same. Roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Freeman, and Corbett. Voting Nay, None.

The petition of property owners in Block 20 Edgewater Heights Addition to the City requesting that the classification be changed from Resident Park to R-3 was presented to the Council and after discussion the matter was referred to the Appeal Board.

The light and water account of the Bonneville Sportsman Assn., for the house at the pheasant pens was presented and it was requested that the account be cancelled. It was agreeable with the Council and the Mayor directed the Clerk to cancel the same.

The matter of the material for the fence at the Cemetery was discussed and it was agreed that the necessary wire should be purchased at this time.

At this point John B. Rogers presented a resolution to place the 116th Engineers' colors in a display case in the City Hall. (resolution on file)

There being no further business to come before the Council it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Corbett that the Meeting adjourn.
