The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Session January 19, 1951, in the Council Chambers at 8:00 P.M. There were present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Councilmen Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers. Absent, Councilman Johnson. There were also present: E. A. Owen, City Attorney, Charles, H. Williams, City Clerk.

Mrs. Battles and Ronald Hammond appeared in behalf of the Idaho Falls Symphony group and asked the City Council if it would be possible for the City to assist in the program by supplying funds which are very badly needed. Mrs. Battles read a letter from the group signed by eleven of the members in which it was stated that the Idaho Statutes provide that a one mill tax can be levied to assist and maintain Bands and Orchestras, Section 50-1601. There are about 35 or 40 persons in the organization. After considerable discussion the matter was taken under advisement.

The residents of Willowbrook Addition and Hill Crest Addition filed a petition with the City requesting that the hazard existing on North Boulevard between Elva Street and Sunset Drive be remedied. The matter was discussed and the Mayor advised that favorable action would be taken and also that street markers and street lights were to be installed.

R. L. Henderson appeared before the City Council and asked that some relief be given to him in an experiment he had made with an electrically heated house. There is no provision in the rate set up from the City for heating houses by electricity and no solution was arrived at.

The proposed ordinance controlling the sale of jewelry at public auction was read by the Clerk on the third and final reading after which it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Rogers that it be approved and passed and the Clerk instructed to publish the same as required by law. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers. Johnson being absent. Voting Nay, None.

An ordinance entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-1306 OF CHAPTER 13, TITLE 1 OF THE REVISED CODE OF IDAHO FALLS, 1950, BY ADDING THERETO A SCHEDULE OF CHARGES FOR WATER HEATING, COMMERCIAL, FOR BUSINESSES AND APARTMENTS."

was read at length by the Clerk. It was moved by Councilman Corbett that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code, requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. It was seconded by Councilman Rogers. Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers; Nay, None. Three-fourths of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "Shall the ordinance pass?" Roll call resulted as follows: Ayes, Freeman, Corbett, and Rogers; Nay, None. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the ordinance passed.

The annual report of the Building Department was presented showing the receipts and expenditures.

There being no further business to come before the Council, it was moved by Rogers and seconded by Corbett that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye, 3. Voting Nay, None.
