

JUNE 6, 1951
SPECIAL MEETING HELD JUNE 6, 1951

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, being called by Mayor E. W. Fanning, into a Special Session June 6, 1951 at 7:30 P.M. for the purpose of accepting the plat of the South Bel-Aire Addition, Division No. 1, and to confer with Mr. Burrows, of Edward L. Burton & Co. regarding bond issue to complete the Civic Auditorium. There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; R. A. Freeman, John B. Rogers, and Donald R. Foote, Councilmen; S. R. Rostad, City Clerk; T. R. Peters, Purchasing Agent; Arthur Smith, City Attorney; Claude Black, City Engineer.

After some discussion on the proposed bond issue to complete the Civic Auditorium, it was moved by Councilman Freeman and seconded by Councilman Foote that the City of Idaho Falls employ the firm of Edward L. Burton & Co., of Salt Lake City, Utah as fiscal agents in setting up the Bonds and etc., for the sum of \$2,000.00 and the Mayor be authorized to sign an agreement or contract to that effect. On roll call voting Aye, Councilmen Rogers, Freeman and Foote. Nay, None. Absent, one. The motion carried.

Mr. Benton presented, for final approval, a plat of South Bel-Aire Addition, Division No. 1. It was moved by Councilman Freeman seconded by Councilman Foote that the plat be accepted and approved as presented, with the provision that deeds are procured for the right of way on Garfield Avenue and performance bonds. On roll call voting Aye, Councilmen Freeman, Foote, and Rogers. Nay, None. Absent, One. The motion carried.

It was moved by Councilman Rogers and seconded by Foote that the Council adjourn. Voting Aye, 3. Nay, None. Absent, One. Motion carried.
