The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho was called by Mayor E. W. Fanning, into a Special Session April 30, 1951 at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of making a canvas of the election results of the election held on April 24, 1951, swearing in the new Councilman, making committee appointments and considering the budget. There were present: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Russell Freeman, Vernon S. Johnson, and John B. Rogers, Councilmen; Charles H. Williams, City Clerk. Corbett Absent.

It was found by the above canvas that Donald R. Foote was elected Councilman and he signed the Official Oath.

Mayor E. W. Fanning made the following appointments:

Streets and Alleys:	Donald R. Foote, Chairman & Russell A. Freeman
Parks, Cemetery & Golf Course:	Russell A. Freeman Chairman & John B. Rogers
Police, Sanitation, Building & Fire:	John B. Rogers, Chairman and Vernon S. Johnson

The appointments were sustained by the Council. It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Rogers that Russell A. Freeman be elected as President of the Council. On roll call it was approved by the Council.

Mr. R. H. Rust appeared for the I. F. Baseball Club and the Old Faithful Beverage Company, with reference to the sale of beer within 300 feet of a public school. After some discussion, the matter was referred to the City Attorney to be brought up for consideration at a later date.

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Freeman that the deduction of \$150.00 made from Joseph F. Charboneau, when Chief of Police, as Police Retirement Fund, be refunded. On roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Johnson, Freeman and Foote.

Mayor Fanning brought before the Council, that Mr. Gifford in behalf of the high school band, had requested a donation of \$400.00. On motion by Freeman and seconded by Johnson, this request was granted. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Foote, Rogers, Johnson. Nay, None.

On motion by Rogers and seconded by Foote, two weeks vacation pay was granted to Charles H. Williams. On roll call, voting Aye, Johnson, Freeman, Foote and Rogers. Nay, None.

The matter of pipe line and conduit to Hughes Heights, was tabled for the time being.
