

NOVEMBER 6, 1950

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Session November 6, 1950 at 8:00 P.M. There were present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Councilmen Johnson, Freeman, and Corbett. Councilman Rogers was absent. Also present: Charles H. Williams, City Clerk; E. A. Owen, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were had.

The minutes of the Meeting held October 20 were read and it was recommended by the Mayor that the wording "South Side School" be changed to read "Eagle Rock School". With this correction, it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Johnson that the minutes be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett and Johnson. Voting Nay, None.

The Finance Committee having audited the claims against the City covering bills for October, recommended that the same be paid. The following was presented for payment:

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the claims be allowed and the Clerk be authorized to draw warrants on the proper funds in payment of the same. Roll call voting Aye, Johnson, Freeman and Corbett. Voting Nay, None.

The monthly reports of the various Departments of the City were read by the Clerk and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Corbett that the reports be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Corbett, Johnson and Freeman. Voting Nay, None.

William S. Holden came before the Council and presented the plot plan of the proposed Blackburn Addition which lies east of Holmes Avenue and north of Ninth Street. After considerable discussion it was agreed that the covenants and agreements on the proposed Addition be submitted in writing.

The application of Jerry M. Thompson for a BARTENDERS permit was presented and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Johnson that it be granted. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Corbett and Johnson.

Joel G. Anderson, Building Inspector, proposed that a slight change be made in the Building Code which had been adopted. He requested that on Page 119 Section 2522 Paragraph 2 the wording be changed to eight feet from seven feet. It was moved by Freeman and seconded by Johnson that a resolution be adopted approving the change. Roll call voting Aye, Johnson, Freeman and Corbett. Voting Nay, None.

There being no further business to come before the Council it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Freeman that the Council Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye, 3. Voting Nay, None.
