

JUNE 16, 1950

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Session June 16, 1950. There were present: Mayor Thomas L. Sutton; Councilmen Johnson, Rogers, Freeman, and Corbett; E. A. Owen, City Attorney and Charles H. Williams, City Clerk.

The Mayor asked if anyone had any problems to bring before the Council and the Lyons Club asked that permission be granted to install drinking fountains on the streets. After some discussion it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Corbett that the Club consult with the City Engineer, Mr. Black, to determine the locations so that the fountains be placed at points where the water runs directly into the sewer. Roll call voting Aye, Corbett, Rogers, Johnson and Freeman. Voting Nay, None.

The plat of the South Hill Crest Subdivision was presented and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Rogers that the plat be accepted. Roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Johnson, Freeman, and Corbett.

Harold Craggs appeared in behalf of the druggists and ask for 5-minute emergency parking near drug stores, the druggists to pay the cost of the necessary additional signs. Councilman Freeman suggested that the request be granted and instruct the Police Department accordingly.

Representatives of 2nd section of Bel Aire Addition ask the Council to consider curb and gutter plans which were submitted and also street paving specifications. The matter was referred to Black, the City Engineer.

This being the time set for opening bids for pump equipment on the new well on West 21st, the following companies bids were opened:

The foregoing petition was referred to the Mayor's Office.

A project application was presented by the C.A.A. and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Johnson that the Mayor be authorized to sign the same. Roll call voting Aye, 4. Voting Nay, None.

A Plat of the proposed Tew Addition was presented to the Council by the Mayor and it was discussed but it was learned there were some problems not yet corrected so no action was taken.

Sewer project application for fees to do necessary preliminary work was presented and it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Johnson that the Mayor be authorized to sign the same. Roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Johnson, Freeman, and Corbett. Voting Nay, None.

There was considerable discussion about water mains after which Freeman moved that all water mains be cast iron pipe in all cases in City jurisdiction. The motion was seconded by Rogers. Roll call voting Aye, 4. Voting Nay, None.

Mr. Peters, City Purchasing Agent, asked for authority to purchase pipe, also 500 service boxes and 300 curb stops. It was moved by Corbett and seconded by Rogers that the request be granted. Roll call voting Aye, 4. Voting Nay, None.

There being no further business to come before the Meeting, the Council adjourned.
