

JUNE 7, 1950

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Regular Session June 7th, 1950, in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. Roll call was made by the Clerk and there were present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Vernon S. Johnson, Russell A. Freeman, and John B. Rogers, Councilmen. Councilman Ross Corbett was absent. Also present: Charles H. Williams, City Clerk and E. A. Owen, City Attorney.

The first business considered by the Council was the claims presented by the Finance Committee and recommended for payment as follows:

It was moved by Rogers and seconded by Johnson that the claims be approved and the Clerk be authorized to issue warrants on the proper funds in payment of the same. Roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Johnson, and Freeman; Nay, None.

The following ordinance was presented:

ORDINANCE NO. 747

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1950-1951, AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS.

The Ordinance was read by the Clerk after which it was moved by Johnson that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code, requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. It was seconded by Councilman Rogers. Roll call voting in favor of this motion: Freeman, Rogers, and Johnson. Voting Nay, None. Three-fourths of the Council having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "Shall the ordinance pass?" Roll call voting Ayes, Rogers, Johnson, and Freeman. Voting Nay, None. Thereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance passed.

The minutes for April 26th, May 3rd, 8th, and 9th, were reviewed briefly by the Clerk and it was moved by Johnson and seconded by Freeman, that the minutes be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Rogers, Johnson, and Freeman.

The Mayor requested that the Council approve the appointment of a Building Examining Board as follows: Woodrow Arrington, Floyd Heyrend, LaVel Goodwin, Harmon Ebeltoft, and

George B. Riches. It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Rogers that the appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye, Freeman, Rogers and Johnson; Voting Nay, None.

Councilman Freeman having another appointment was excused at this time.

The Mayor asked if anyone had anything to come before the Council and Melvin Brown, representing the Jaycees, introduced Phil Leighie and he presented the problem of the swimming pool and requested that the City match funds with the Jaycees 50-50 in completing the project. He stated that the approximate cost of the construction would be about \$125,000.00. The Mayor advised that the matter could be discussed further at a later Meeting.

Cardston Bronken came before the Council with a plan which had been asked for on the construction of a sewer line in the southeast part of the City to relieve the present overloaded sewer and to handle further expansion. Mr. Bronken presented a plan and also an application for Government aid. The Mayor referred the matter to the City Engineer and City Council for study and consideration.

At this time, Jack Weber appeared before the Council and requested that some action be taken to cover the Idaho Canal in the City limits to protect children from drowning. The Mayor agreed that some action should be taken and asked that Mr. Weber advise that the residents come in as a Committee and meet with the City Council in a Meeting which is to be held June 16th, at 8:00 P.M.

The following applications for licenses were presented:

The fees having been paid the Clerk issued the licenses, final approval to be obtained at a later Meeting when a quorum is present.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the Meeting was adjourned.
