

APRIL 21, 1950

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho met in Regular Session April 21, 1950. There was present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Corbett, Rogers, Johnson, and Freeman, Councilmen; Charles H. Williams, City Clerk and E. A. Owen, City Attorney.

It was moved by Rogers and seconded by Freeman that the foregoing application be granted. Roll call voting Aye; Rogers, Johnson, Freeman and Corbett. The motion carried.

The Mayor asked the Council to approve his appointment to the Public Library Board, of Mrs. Bryan and E. A. Owen. It was moved by Freeman and seconded by Johnson, that the appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye; Freeman, Corbett, Rogers, and Johnson. The motion carried.

W. J. O'Bryant, representing the local Fair Board, presented a plat of the ground east of the horse barn at Tautphaus Park, on which the board proposed to build aluminum buildings which could be expanded when the necessity required. Mr. O'Bryant asked the approval of the Council to construct the buildings and after considerable discussion Councilman Freeman suggested the proposal be submitted to the Planning Board for study and recommendation to the Council.

The Willow Brook Plat was presented to the Council to be checked over after which it was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the plat be signed after the easements were drawn up. Roll call voting Aye; Corbett, Rogers, Johnson and Freeman. The motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Council, it was moved by Freeman and seconded by Rogers that this Meeting be recessed to Wednesday April 26, at 8:00 P.M. Roll call voting Aye; Rogers, Johnson, Freeman and Corbett.
