

MARCH 30, 1950

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Special Session, March 30, 1950, at 10:30 P.M. in response to Notice of Special Meeting requested by the Mayor. There was present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Ross Corbett, John B. Rogers, and Vernon S. Johnson, Councilmen. Russell A. Freeman being absent. Also present: Charles H. Williams, City Clerk.

The following requests were made by McAbee and Hykes:

GARAGES FOR DUPLEXES

Garages to be built on lot line.

Garages on adjacent lots under one roof as per plans as submitted previously to the City Building.

GARAGES FOR SINGLE DUPLEXES

Garages when located on rear one-third of lot be built on lot lines.

All duplexes in Linden Park Subdivision – front yard setback of 20 feet, as shown on plot plan of Division No. 1. Street cross section using a 36 foot paved surface measured from back of curb to back of curb. Roll type curb and gutter with a 5 foot sidewalk adjacent to roll curb. Permission to use pit run gravel from house basement excavations after elimination of gravel over 2 inches in size from road sub base.

After discussion by the Mayor and members of the Council, the Mayor asked for a motion approving the requests.

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the request be granted as to the second section of Linden Park Addition, being Blocks 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10. Roll call in favor of the motion was noted “Aye” by all members of the Council present.

The Mayor then called to the Council the Tew Addition and stated that it had been requested that Division Avenue be approved at a width of 38 feet plus 6 feet on each side for sidewalks. It was moved by Corbett and seconded by Rogers that this request be granted. All Councilmen voted “Aye” on this motion.

The Mayor requested that the Council approve the appointments to the Planning Commission of A. W. Brunt, Leonard Wright, Chet Taylor and Stanley Gagon. It was moved by Corbett and seconded by Rogers that the appointments be approved. Roll call voting Aye; Rogers, Johnson and Corbett.

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the applications presented be approved and the Clerk authorized to issue the proper license. On roll call all Councilmen present voted "Aye".

A preliminary plat was submitted at the request of Homer Koster Co., which covered land in the south part of the City. After some discussion it was taken under advisement.

There had been some questions concerning the Building Inspector requesting specifications being filed in his office before issuing building permits and the Mayor asked Joel G. Anderson to explain his position on the matter which he did.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the Meeting adjourned.
