

MARCH 7, 1950

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, met in Regular Session March 7, 1950, in the Council Chambers at Idaho Falls, Idaho. There was present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Councilmen Corbett, Johnson, and Rogers. There was also present: Charles H. Williams, City Clerk and E. A. Owen, City Attorney.

The minutes of the Meeting held February 17, 1950, were read by the Clerk after which it was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that said minutes be approved. The members of Council present voted unanimous approval.

At this time the Mayor asked if there was anyone present that had any business to bring before the Council and Mrs. Gordon Wilson came forward, representing the Idaho Falls Garden Club. She commented on the parks of Idaho Falls and on the work done by Russell Freeman with reference to establishing the parks and helping to beautify them and then proposed that the City Council name the park north of the River bridge on both sides of the River Freeman Park in honor of Mr. Freeman. The Mayor asked that the matter be tabled for the present. It was moved by Corbett and seconded by Johnson, that the matter be tabled. Roll call voting Aye; Corbett and Johnson. Voting Nay; Rogers. The motion carried.

A re-plat of the Willow Brook Addition was presented to the Council for approval and the matter was taken under advisement.

Jay Roberts and Ivo Jeffrey came before the City Council and requested permission to operate two mobile food markets on the streets of Idaho Falls at a lower license fee than had been charged for 1949. The Mayor advised them that \$100.00 is the license fee as set up by ordinance and that any further protest on the fee should be taken up with the City Attorney.

The Finance Committee having tabulated the bills for the month of February recommended the following bills be allowed:

It was moved by Rogers and seconded by Corbett that the bills be allowed and the Clerk authorized to draw warrants on the proper funds in payment of the same. The vote in support of the motion was unanimous.

The monthly reports of the various Departments were read by the Clerk and it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Johnson that they be approved. The vote for approval was unanimous.

It was moved by Rogers and seconded by Johnson that the foregoing applications be granted and the Clerk authorized to issue the licenses. The vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Mr. Black, City Engineer, requested that the Council authorize the City Clerk to publish a notice calling for bids to construct a bridge over the canal at 15th and Higbee. It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the Clerk publish a notice in The Post Register calling for bids on the construction of said bridge. Roll call voting Aye; Corbett, Rogers and Johnson. The motion carried.

Mr. Peters the City Purchasing Agent, requested permission to purchase pipe and other connections for the Water Department consisting of approximately \$8,773.00. It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that Mr. Peters be authorized to purchase the necessary pipe and connections required to extend water lines and also to make the present necessary reports. The members of the Council voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

At this time Ferris Clark came before the Council and requested that the R-3 zone on the west side of the river facing the river be extended 25 feet further north. After an explanation of the conditions surrounding the request it was moved by Johnson and seconded by Rogers that the R-3 zone be shifted 25 feet north on the west side of the river on the property facing on the river. Roll call voting Aye; Corbett, Rogers, and Johnson. The motion carried.

At this time Mr. Owen, City Attorney, presented a contract which had been discussed in the Meeting of February 17th by Mr. Chesbro with reference to a parking lot to be rented to the City by the City Improvement Association, Inc., of Idaho Falls. Mr. Owen stated that he had examined the

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contract and recommended that the City enter into the contract. It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the Mayor be authorized to sign the contract. The members of the Council voted unanimously in favor.

There being no further business to come before the Council it was moved by Johnson and seconded by Corbett that the Meeting adjourn. The Council agreed unanimously.
