

FEBRUARY 24, 1950

A Special Council Meeting called February 24, 1950, to consider the admission to the City of additional land. There were present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Councilmen Ross Corbett, Vernon S. Johnson and John B. Rogers. Also present: Charles H. Williams, City Clerk. R. A. Freeman being absent.

A proposed ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO.

The foregoing ordinance was read by the Clerk after which it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Johnson that the proposed addition be admitted to the City of Idaho Falls. Roll call showed the members of the Council present voted unanimously in favor of the proposal. John B. Rogers moved that the rule requiring an ordinance to be read at three Meetings be suspended and the foregoing ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. The Council voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

The ordinance was read on the second reading and it was moved by Johnson and seconded by Rogers that the ordinance be passed on the second reading. On roll call the members of the Council voted unanimously in favor of the motion. Whereupon the ordinance was read the third time and it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Johnson that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and the Clerk be authorized to publish the same. The Councilmen voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

A proposed ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO.

The foregoing ordinance was read by the Clerk after which it was moved by Rogers and seconded by Corbett that the proposed ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call showed all Councilmen present voted in favor of the motion.

Whereupon, Councilman Johnson moved that the rule requiring an ordinance to be read at three Meetings be suspended and the ordinance be placed on the second and third readings. On roll call the members of the Council voted unanimously in favor of the motion. The ordinance was read the second time and it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Rogers that it be passed on the second reading. Roll call voting Aye; Johnson, Corbett, and Rogers. Voting Nay; None. The motion carried.

The ordinance was read the third time and it was moved by Corbett and seconded by Rogers that the ordinance be passed on the third and final reading and the Clerk be authorized to publish the same as required by law. Roll call voting Aye; Corbett, Rogers and Johnson. Voting Nay; None. The motion carried.

RESOLUTION

"Be it resolved that the second section of the Bel-Aire Addition be admitted to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and that the Mayor, City Clerk and City Engineer be authorized to sign the plat of the same also that proper maps be filed with the City Clerk." It was moved by Corbett and seconded by Johnson that the foregoing resolution be approved. Roll call voting Aye; Johnson, Rogers and Corbett. Voting Nay; None. The motion carried and the original plats were signed.

There being no further business to come before the Meeting it was moved by Rogers that the Council Meeting adjourn. The vote was unanimous in favor.
