

SEPTEMBER 8, 1949

September 8, 1949 the City Council met in a Recessed Meeting. There were present: Thomas L. Sutton, Mayor; Charles H. Williams, City Clerk; Councilmen Johnson and Freeman. Councilman Corbett was absent.

This being the date which has been advertised for the opening of bids on a new well, the following bids were opened:

Cushman and Johnson	18,200.00
Cope Drilling & Pump Co.	17,375.00
A. J. Schoonover & Son	18,875.00

Due to the absence of Mr. Corbett and the resignation of Mr. Crabtree, there was not enough Councilmen present to constitute a quorum so no action could be taken. The Mayor referred the bids to Mr. Black, City Engineer and Councilman Johnson and the Committee on Light and Water.

It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call, Voting Aye; Freeman and Johnson.
