"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 594 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 607 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 616; PROVIDING THAT THE LICENSE FEES TO BE PAID FOR COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES SHALL BE PAYABLE QUARTER-ANNUALLY; FIXING THE AMOUNT OF SUCH LICENSE FEES AND THE TIME OF PAYMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A PORTION THEREOF TO THE STATE OF IDAHO AND BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO."

The ordinance was then numbered 622 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him the Mayor, duly signed, and approved and ordered published in the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Contract with United States Department of the Interior Bureau of Reclamation covering future delivery of electric service was read.
