

**FEBRUARY 18, 1949**

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Absent: Freeman; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for licenses were read:

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS INTO SIX ELECTION PRECINCTS AND FIXING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; REQUIRING ALL ELECTORS TO REGISTER OR RE-REGISTER IN ORDER TO VOTE AT THE CITY ELECTIONS IN APRIL, 1949; REPEALING CHAPTER 2, TITLE 1, IDAHO FALLS CODE OF 1943 AND ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. It was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 621, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following Resolution was read:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho,  
That the President and Congress of the United States be, and they hereby are urged and requested, through appropriate budgetary action and financial support, to provide for the

extension of the term of experimental or temporary certificates of convenience and necessity of local or feeder airlines, including that of Empire Airlines, Inc., from three to five years.
