AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 594 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 607; PROVIDING THAT THE LICENSE FEES TO BE PAID FOR COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES SHALL BE PAYABLE QUARTER-ANNUALLY; FIXING THE AMOUNT OF SUCH LICENSE FEES AND THE TIME OF PAYMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A PORTION THEREOF TO THE STATE OF IDAHO AND BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO.
