Notice to contractors calling for bids for the construction of a re-enforced concrete bridge over the Porter Canal on West Broadway was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids to be opened September 24th, 1948. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO," was read in full by the City Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 615 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and

approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Meeting was adjourned.
