Will you kindly consider this letter to be my claim for damages sustained by me on June 5, 1948, when my son, Gerry Haws, was drowned at Tautphaus Park by reason of the negligence of the City of Idaho Falls in maintaining a swimming pool accessible to young children attracted to this park by the zoo and amusement devices, and also attracted to the pool by a raft which was unsafe for children to play on, all without a lifeguard, and without any kind of safety device.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls is the owner of the following described land in Bonneville, Idaho.

Beginning at a point on the west line of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 11, Township 2 North, Range 37 E. B. M. that is 25 feet south of the northwest corner of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Section 11, and running thence south 200 feet along said west line, thence east 100 feet parallel to the north line of said NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> , thence north 200 feet parallel to the west line of said NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> thence west 100 feet parallel to the north line of said NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to the point of beginning, containing 0.46 acres, more or less,

Which property is not needed for public purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That said property shall be sold for cash at public auction to the highest bidder, pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 49-138 Idaho Code Annotated, and that H. J. Compton, W. Fisher Ellsworth, and Albert H. Dent, three disinterested residents and freeholders of the City of Idaho Falls, be, and they hereby are appointed as appraisers to appraise said property.
