Applications for Bartender's permits signed by Claude Russell and Bernard J. Marron were read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Application for a Dance Hall license signed by the Saddle & Bridle Club was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the license be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for Slot Machine licenses were read: Saddle & Bridle Club, Home Town Ice Cream Store, Ford's Cigar Store, and The Russett. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The application for Building Permit No. 859, signed by Rudman & Gottberg was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1948-1949, AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the City Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the City Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final

reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 613 and passed to the Mayor for his

approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Modification of lease with Western Amusement Co. covering the operation of amusement equipment, rides, refreshment booths at Tautphaus Park was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Lease of horse barn at Tautphaus to Leslie Skelton for the operation of a riding academy was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Lease of Lots 4-5 and 6, in Block 50 of the original town-site of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, to the Young Men's Christian Association for fifty years was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Application for use of Armory to promote athletic events by the Idaho Falls National Guard was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign an Agreement with the National Guard for the use of the Armory to operate and sponsor athletic events. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the City pay Fireman T. A. Prestgard's expenses for three days at the Firemen's Convention in Salt Lake City, Utah. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
