Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held March 19<sup>th</sup>, 1948, were recorded.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Absent: Freeman; when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

Application for Bartender's Permit signed by J. Paul Deffinger was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for licenses were read:

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance No. 609 entitled "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF ARIZONA AVENUE IN WEST BROADWAY ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, AS PROVIDED BY LAW," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 609 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application from Old Faithful Beverage Company to place waste paper receptacles on the sidewalk in the business district intersections was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that permission be granted to place the cans on the sidewalks as requested. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

To the Honorable Mayor and City Council  
Of Idaho Falls, Idaho

“At a regular meeting of the Idaho Falls YMCA held Tuesday, March 9, 1948, it was moved, duly seconded by, and unanimously passed that the Idaho Falls Young Men’s Christian Association, incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho, as a non-profit, non-sectarian, character building organization, herewith petitions the City of Idaho Falls to make available by lease to the Idaho Falls Young Men’s Christian Association lots Four, Five and Six in Block number Fifty, at the corner of Walnut and North Placer Avenue in the Original Town Site, on which the YMCA will erect a building to be used in keeping with the aims and purposes of said YMCA. The lease to run for not less than Fifty years, and for a minimum monetary consideration to make said lease legal and binding.

In the interest of the youth and the general welfare of the citizens of Idaho Falls, we pray that the above petition will be granted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, is the owner of the following described real property situate in Bonneville County, Idaho, to-wit:

Lots Four (4), Five (5), and Six (6) in Block Fifty (50) of the Original Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and

WHEREAS, said property was not acquired, and is not used as a public park, playground, or public building site and is not needed for municipal purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that said property be offered for lease and that sealed bids, if any, be received for leasing said property at any time before April 16, 1948, at 8:00 P.M., and that the City Clerk publish a notice of intention to lease said property as provided by Chapter 204 Idaho Session Laws 1947.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the City advertise for a lease of the three lots to the YMCA. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for widows allowance on water and light accounts were read: Mrs. Ester M. Davis and Mrs. Eliza A. Wilding. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign an Agreement with the School Board for the operation of the High School Swimming Pool. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to lease for three years to Ross Corbit, the lunch counter concession at the Municipal Golf Course Clubhouse Building. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that notice to contractors be published for bids for labor to re-roof the Club House at the Municipal Golf Course. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting recess until March 26<sup>th</sup>, 1948, at 8 o'clock P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Meeting was adjourned.
