Councilman Sutton introduced Idaho Falls Ordinance No. 608 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AMENDED ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 19 IN AND FOR IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND DELIVERY OF PART OF THE BONDS AUTHORIZED BY IDAHO FALLS ORDINANCE NO. 605 AND THE CANCELLATION OF THE REMAINING BONDS; RATIFYING AND APPROVING ALL ACTION HERETOFORE TAKEN BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE OFFICERS OF IDAHO FALLS RELATING TO THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT AND THE ISSUANCE OF THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BONDS OF THE CITY AUTHORIZED BY SAID ORDINANCE NO. 605 AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT," and moved that the Ordinance be adopted and passed by the Council of its first reading. The motion was seconded by Councilman Freeman, and the same being put to a vote was unanimously carried by the affirmative vote of the Mayor and all Councilmen present. It was moved by Councilman Freeman, that the rules of the City Council be suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. The motion was seconded by Councilman Sutton, and the same being put to a vote was unanimously carried by the affirmative vote of the Mayor and all Councilmen present. It was moved by Councilman Crabtree, that the Ordinance having passed its third reading be adopted, and the Clerk was instructed to publish the same as required by law. The motion was seconded by Councilmen Wasley, and the same being put to a vote was unanimously carried, the vote being as follows:

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
