

AUGUST 19, 1947

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 15th, 1947, and recessed until August 19th, 1947, were recorded.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Crabtree, Wasley; Absent: Sutton; when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for Bartender's Permit were read: Charles Holmer, Marion R. Hulett, Hubert E. Risley, Carl Monson, George Hansen, and Harry Sacolick. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for Coin-operated Amusement Device licenses were read: Hotel Rogers, Whitehorse Bar, Inc., and New Grand Bar. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and the Committee on Streets of the City Council have made out an Assessment Roll for Local Improvement District No. 19 according to the provisions of Ordinance No. 584, and have certified the same to the Council as provided by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That Friday the fifth day of September, 1947, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. of said day, at the Council Chambers in the City Building in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, be, and the same hereby are appointed and fixed as the time and place when and where objections to said Assessment Roll by the property owners in said District shall be heard, and that said Assessment Roll be filed in the office of the City Clerk.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF ROLLANDET AVENUE IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNER OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, AS PROVIDED BY LAW", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read

in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None;

Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 604, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, JOHN ADAMS AND OLIVE E. ADAMS, his wife, executed and delivered to the City of Idaho Falls a certain Warranty Deed dated March 26, 1941, recorded in Book 46 of Deeds at Page 138, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, and another Warranty Deed dated September 12, 1944 and recorded in Book 50 of Deeds at Page 568, records of Bonneville County, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the property conveyed thereby is erroneously described;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor of the City of Idaho Falls is hereby authorized and directed to accept a corrected warranty Deed from the said Grantors to the City of Idaho Falls, correctly describing the property conveyed.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed Mrs. George P. Bryan and Emery A. Owen for another term on the Library Board. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the appointments be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor stated that the City could now purchase a new Studebaker truck from the Roy J. Keller Company for about \$1,900.00. This truck to be used in the Garbage Department. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor and Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase the truck. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
