Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 16<sup>th</sup>, 1947, were read.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following application for Journeyman Electrician's license was read: I. L. Bray. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the license be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 594 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, BY ADDING A SECTION THERETO TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 7-A, PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES AND PUNCH BOARDS IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 1:00 O'CLOCK A.M. SUNDAY AND 7:00 O'CLOCK A.M. MONDAY OF ANY WEEK, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 596 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Pot Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for building permit No. 284 requesting permission to bury one 1000 gallon fuel oil tank in rear of 481 Broadway on Market Street signed by V. L. Clark was read. It was moved by

Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the application be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.
