

APRIL 18, 1947

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Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 18<sup>th</sup>, 1947 were read.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Absent: Sutton; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting and Special Meeting held April 14<sup>th</sup>, 1947 were read and approved.

An application for Master Plumber license signed by Ernest Terry was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for Coin-operated Amusement Device Machines were read:

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ELECTING THAT THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS COME UNDER AND COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF HOUSE BILL NO. 111, PASSED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, 29<sup>th</sup> SESSION, AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR OF IDAHO MARCH 4, 1947, RELATING TO THE CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF POLICEMAN'S RETIREMENT FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF A BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE POLICEMAN'S RETIREMENT FUND AND SPECIFYING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR A LEVY UPON ALL ASSESSED PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER LEVIES FOR RAISING FUNDS TO BE PLACED IN SAID POLICEMAN'S RETIREMENT FUND FOR THE PURPOSE PROVIDED IN SAID STATE LAW AND THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT INTO SAID FUND OF THREE PER CENT PER MONTH OF THE COMPENSATION PAID TO POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY AND PROVIDING FOR DEDUCTING SAID AMOUNT EACH MONTH FROM THE SALARY OF SUCH POLICE OFFICER BY THE CITY TREASURER AND PLACING SAME IN SAID POLICEMAN'S RETIREMENT FUND; PROVIDING FOR CARRYING OUT BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS OF THE PROVISIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF SAID STATE LAW; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN SO FAR AS THEY ARE IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING A TIME FOR THE TAKING EFFECT OF THIS ORDINANCE", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman,

Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings

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be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Crabtree; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 595 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Sealed bids will be received by Lee Walker, City Clerk, at the City Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho, until 8:00 o'clock P.M. May 16, 1947, for the construction of the following improvements and will then and there be opened and publicly read.

Grade and construct approximately 20 miles of concrete sidewalk involving about 11,500 cubic yards of common excavation; 22,000 station yards of overhaul (1,000 feet free haul), 71,000 square yards of 4 inch concrete sidewalk; 445 square yards of 6 inch concrete side walk; 120 linear feet gutter plate supports, and 120 linear feet gutter plates.

Plans, specifications and form of contract documents may be examined at the office of the City Engineer and at the office of the City Clerk, City Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho and a set of plans, specifications and forms may be obtained at the offices of either of the above deposit of \$10.00 payable to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Sealed bids will be received by Lee Walker, City Clerk at the City Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho, until 8:00 o'clock P.M. May 16, 1947 for the construction of the improvements and will then and there be opened and publicly read.

Grading and constructing approximately (2.5) two and one-half miles of paved streets with drainage, curb and gutter involving about 8,245 cu. yards common excavation; 25,000 station yards (1,000 feet free haul) over haul; 3,000 cubic yards gravel re-handling; 6,250 cubic yards base course crushed gravel; 18,050 linear feet integral straight curb and gutter in place; 1,200 linear feet integral alley returns in place; 1,046 linear feet concrete headers in place; 9 manhole tops adjust to grade; 21 concrete catch-basins, with top and covers in place; 844 linear feet 4" concrete drain tile furnished in place; 531 linear feet 6" concrete drain tile furnished in place; 10 catch-basins removed; 300 linear feet concrete headers removed; 1,629 linear feet concrete curb removed; 60 linear feet concrete curb & gutter removed; 153 linear feet concrete returns removed; 10,320 gallons asphaltic prime coat (MC-1); 10,320 gallons asphaltic seal coat (MC-3); 585 tons cover coat material; 37,080 square yards of wearing course of concrete, vitrified brick, macadam, asphaltic concrete, asphaltic concrete with tempering medium added, asphaltic concrete using (MC-5), or natural rock asphalt.
