Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 4<sup>th</sup>, 1947 and recessed until April 8<sup>th</sup>, 1947, were read. An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES AS DEFINED BY HOUSE BILL NO. 43 ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF IDAHO AT THE 29<sup>th</sup> SESSION; PROVIDING THE LICENSE FEES TO BE PAID FOR EACH SUCH MACHINE OR DEVICE AND THE PAYMENT OF THE PORTION THEREOF TO THE STATE OF IDAHO AND BONNEVILLE COUNTY AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW; PROVIDING REGULATIONS AND CONTROLS FOR THE OPERATION OF SAID MACHINES AND LICENSING THE SAME; PROVIDING THE FORM OF LICENSE OR STAMP TO BE OBTAINED AND DISPLAYED AND CANCELLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE FURNISHING OF FORMS FOR APPLICATION FOR LICENSE; PROVIDING FOR A PRO-RATING OF LICENSE FEES FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SUBSTITUTE LICENSE IN CASE A MACHINE LICENSES IS BROKEN, DESTROYED, OR HAS BECOME USELESS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF LICENSES AND FOR NOTICE OF HEARING PRECEDING SUCH REVOCATION; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 573 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the rule be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 594, and passed to the

Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.
