RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated March 13, 1946, recorded in Book 52 of Deeds at Page 190 of the records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of the South 64 feet of Lot 30 and the center 14 feet of Lot 31 in Block 2 of the Original Townsite of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof, and

WHEREAS, R. E. BILLS of Idaho Falls, Idaho, has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

BILLS for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls a Deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.
