

FEBRUARY 21, 1947

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held February 21st, 1947, were read.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Absent: Freeman; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit: Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

Jack Pouch appeared before the City Council, and requested the City to furnish water to about fifteen property owners on the west side.

He stated that they would put in their own eight-inch water line to connect onto the City eight-inch line on West Broadway. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the City will furnish water to the property owners when they get their water line constructed, and sign an Agreement with the City. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Owner of the Yellow Cab Company appeared before the City Council, and requested the use of three parking spaces at 425 B Street, as he was moving his Taxi Stand from 368 Broadway to 425 B Street. The Mayor referred the matter to the Street Committee.

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated February 8, 1947, recorded in Book 52 of Deeds at Page 518, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of Lots 27 and 28, in Block 7, of Crow's Addition to the Original Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof, and

WHEREAS, ONA H. LARSON, of Idaho Falls, Idaho, has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of Assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said ONA H. LARSON for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING ALL OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 3 OF WEST BROADWAY ADDITION IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE AS PROVIDED BY LAW" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on it's first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 592, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was, by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 593 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

A letter from Cecil S. Stalker, President of Carpenters' Union, Local No. 609 regarding the construction of prefabricated houses in the City of Idaho Falls was read. The Mayor referred the letter to the Building Inspector and City Attorney.

Application for a Beer license for the new Grand Bar at No. 225 1/2 Broadway signed by Robert M. Atkeson was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the license not be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

FEBRUARY 21, 1947

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that Cash Warrant No. 1406 dated February 10th, 1947 for \$50,000.00 to A. G. Schoonmaker Co. be paid out of General Fund instead of the Electric Fund. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting recess until March 1st, 1947. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.
