Minutes of the last regular Meeting, and of a Special Meeting held January 27th, 1947, were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Supt., Street & Park Commissioner, Sanitary & Meat Inspectors, Chief of Fire Department, Electrical Inspector, Plumbing Inspector.

Walter Williams appeared before the City Council and requested the City to pay the cost of moving his house out of the Street on Blaine Avenue. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City pay \$100.00 to Walter Williams to have his house moved out of the Street onto his lots.
