It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING ALL OF RIVER AVENUE, ALL OF TROUT STREET, AND ALL OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 74 RIVERSIDE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on it's first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that any Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.
