Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held October 18th, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wasley, Freeman, Crabtree; Absent: Sutton; when the following proceedings were had to wit: Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Agreements with Union Pacific Railroad Company covering Highway on right of way and Power Redistributing Tower Sight were read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

OCTOBER 18, 1946

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and necessary for the City of Idaho Falls to lay out and construct a street or road from U. S. Highway No. 91 to the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport; said road running on and across the following described tract of land, to wit:

Beginning at a point 300 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 4, Section 13, Township 2, North, Range 37 East of the Boise Meridian, in Bonneville County, Idaho, and running thence East 418 feet, thence North 11° 50' East 204.8 feet, thence West 460 feet, thence South 0° 0' East 200.5 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less.

AND, WHEREAS, several individuals own a interest in said tract of land and the City officials have made diligent inquiry and effort to ascertain the whereabouts of said owners but have been unable to locate all of them or ascertain the place of residence or Post Office address of all of them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City Attorney be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute and prosecute eminent domain proceedings against the owners of said land for the purpose of acquiring, taking and using same for the purpose of a public street or highway, and the following described portion of the above described tract of land is required by the City for said street or highway:

Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of the existing Airport Road which is 718.0 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 4, Section 13, Township 2 North, Range 11° 50' East 204.8 feet along said Westerly line of existing Airport Road thence West 44.35 feet, thence following a 6° 20' curve to the right to a point which is South 6° 34' West, 136.88 feet, thence South 10° 54' West 65.23 feet, thence East 29.83 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.17 acres, more or less.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the said land, easements and right of way hereinbefore described are necessary for the public use as hereinbefore set forth and are hereby appropriated and dedicated to public use, to wit, as sites for the construction of a street or highway from U. S. Highway No. 91 to the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

OCTOBER 18, 1946

Application for widow's allowance on water and light account signed by Lola Hampton was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Virgil E. Howard appeared before the City Council, and requested permission to place a dining car on the rear of Lot at 745 Park Avenue. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that Mr. Howard be granted permission to place the dining car on this lot. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn.
