

SEPTEMBER 20, 1946

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 20th, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Freeman; Absent: Wasley; when the following proceedings were had to wit: Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for licenses were read:

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Contract with Union Pacific Railroad Company covering water pipe line crossing was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the contract. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FIXTURES, EQUIPMENT AND APPLIANCES FOR USING LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; REQUIRING A PERMIT BEFORE INSTALLING ANY SUCH EQUIPMENT, AND PROVIDING THE FEES FOR SUCH PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION OF SUCH INSTALLATION AND PROHIBITING THE INSTALLATION OF SUCH EQUIPMENT WITHOUT A PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF WORK, AND THE INSPECTION THEREOF, AND FOR A FEE FOR SUCH PERMIT AND INSPECTION; PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE TO ANY PERSON INSTALLING SUCH EQUIPMENT, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on it's third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 589 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for widow's allowance on water & light account signed by Leslie McMullen and Lillie Carlson were read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the regular allowance be granted to Leslie McMullen and the application of Lillie Carlson be rejected. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 8th day of October, 1936.
