Application for Electrical Contractor's license signed by Billz Signz Co. was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

A Petition to construct a grocery store at 440 West 21st Street signed by Lloyd H. and Jeanette C. Ryder was read. The Mayor referred the Petition to the Board of Adjustment.

Lease No. 8952 and No. 9289 with the Union Pacific Railroad Company were read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

SEPTEMBER 7, 1946

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Clerk, pursuant to a Resolution duly passed and approved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Idaho Falls on the 7th day of August, 1946, advertised, as provided by law, the following described real property for sale at public auction, to wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 171, Block 12, Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and running thence West 50.0 feet to the S. W. corner of Lot 18; thence North, 40.6 feet along the West line of Lot 18 to the Easterly line of U. S. Highway No. 191; thence N. 36° 26' E., 84.1 feet along said Easterly line of U. S. Highway No. 191 to the East line of Lot 17; thence South along the East line of Lot 17, 108.2 to the point of beginning, being that portion of Lots 17 and 18, Block 12, Capitol Hill Addition lying East of U. S. Highway No. 191.

WHEREAS, FORD GARDNER did offer and bid therefore the sum of THIRTY FIVE HUNDRED dollars, (\$3,500.00), which said sum was the highest sum offered and the best bid made for said land, being the full appraised value thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the said bid of FORD GARDNER for said land in the amount of \$3,500.00 be, and the same hereby is accepted and approved and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a Deed to said land to said FORD GARDNER for and in behalf and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, conveying to said FORD GARDNER all the right, title and interest of the City of Idaho Falls in and to said land.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Voting Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed H. M. Groesbeck as a member of the Board of Appeals. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FIXTURES, EQUIPMENT AND APPLIANCES FOR USING LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; REQUIRING A PERMIT BEFORE INSTALLING ANY SUCH EQUIPMENT, AND PROVIDING THE FEES FOR SUCH PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION OF SUCH INSTALLATION AND PROHIBITING THE INSTALLATION OF SUCH EQUIPMENT WITHOUT A PERMIT: PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF WORK, AND THE INSPECTION THEREOF, AND FOR A FEE FOR SUCH PERMIT AND INSPECTION; PROVIDING FOR A LICENSE TO ANY PERSON INSTALLING SUCH EQUIPMENT AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
