

AUGUST 15, 1946

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 15th, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; when the following proceedings were had, to wit:
Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE PLAT AND DEDICATION OF STREETS AND ALLEYS IN THE RAPPLEYE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 588 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.
