Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1946, and recessed until August 7<sup>th</sup>, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; when the following proceedings were had to wit; Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Supt., Street & Park Comm., Sanitary & Meat Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, Plumbing Inspector, Electrical Inspector.

Application for Master Plumber license signed by Harvey G. Sautter was read. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

To the City Council of Idaho Falls

Gentlemen:

I have two thousand feet of 4 inch waterline in and will have four hundred feet more at the end of the week on the west side of river. We have 14 buildings and no fire hydrants for protection.

We would appreciate it if the City would furnish us a hydrant.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the request for the City to furnish a fire hydrant be rejected, as Mr. Brothers property is outside the City limits. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Agreement between the Union Pacific RR Co. and the City covering purchase of electrical power was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls is the owner of the property-----

“Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 17, Block 12, Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and running thence West, 50.0 feet to the S. W. corner of Lot 18; thence North 40.6 feet along the west line of Lot 18 to the Easterly line of U. S. Highway No. 191; thence N. 36° 26’ R., 84.1 feet along said Easterly line of U. S. Highway No. 191 to the East line of Lot 17; thence South along the East line of Lot 17, 108.2 feet to the point of beginning, being that portion of Lots 17 and 18, Block 12, Capitol Hill Addition lying East of U. S. Highway No. 191 which property is not needed for public purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that said property shall be sold for cash at public auction to the highest bidder, pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-138 Idaho Code Annotated, and that E. A. Wackerli, Harry L. Mooney, and Joe Dennis, three disinterested residents and freeholders of the City of Idaho Falls be, and they hereby are appointed as appraisers to appraise said property.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Application for widow’s allowance on water and light account signed by Catherine Geddes was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Contract with General Electric Co. covering services of Engineer was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the contract. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

A letter from Joe Blenkle, State Softball Commissioner, requesting the City to construct a lighted softball field was read. The Mayor and City Council took the matter under advisement.

The Mayor appointed J. Frank Julian as a member of the Board of Adjustment. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.

Passed and approved this 15<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1946.
