

MAY 17, 1946

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Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 17<sup>th</sup>, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Absent: Freeman; when the following proceedings were had to wit: Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

Budget Estimate for the Fiscal Year 1946-1947 was presented and read to the City Council as follows:

**BUDGET ESTIMATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1946-1947, CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO**

The following is an estimate of the amount of money necessary for all purposes to be raised by taxation or otherwise in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, during the Fiscal Year 1946-1947, for which, an Appropriation is to be made as provided by law; said money to be apportioned for the purpose of paying indebtedness now existing and to accrue against the various Funds of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho; it-wit:

The Mayor referred the petition to the Street Committee and City Engineer.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF AN UNNAMED STREET IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, AS PROVIDED BY LAW" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings, be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 585 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following advertisement for bids was read:

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed bids will be received by Lee Walker, City Clerk, at the City Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho, until 8:00 o'clock P.M. June 17<sup>th</sup>, 1946, for the construction of the following improvements and will then and there be opened and publicly read.

1. Grading and constructing ten (10) miles of paved streets with drainage, curb and gutter involving about 54,700 cubic yards of common excavation; 7,000 cubic yards salvageable gravel base; 150,000 station yards overhaul (1,000 feet free haul); 35,000 cubic  
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yards crushed base course gravel; 108,047 lineal feet straight curb and gutter; 4,593 linear feet curved curb and gutter; 3,600 feet alley gutter returns; 4,230 linear feet headers; 60,000 gallons asphaltic prime coat (MC-1); 60,000 gallons asphaltic seal coat (MC-3); 3,400 tons cover coat material; 215,414 square yards of wearing course of concrete, vitrified brick, macadam, asphaltic concrete using (MC-5), or natural rock asphalt; remove 15 catch basins; remove 1,057 linear feet concrete headers; remove 1,370 linear feet of concrete curb; remove 335 linear feet of concrete curb and gutter; remove 690 linear feet of concrete returns; remove 300 feet concrete sidewalk; remove 30 trees (approximate diameter 24 inches); remove and replant 75 trees (approximate diameter 4 inches); furnish and install 102 catch basins; furnish and install 5,054 linear feet 4 inch concrete drain pipe; furnish and install 3,865 linear feet of 6 inch concrete drain tile, and adjust to grade 58 manhole covers and 24 valve boxes.

2. Grade and construct approximately 20 miles of concrete sidewalk involving about 11,500 cubic yards of common excavation; 22,000 station-yards of overhaul (1,000 feet free haul); 71,000 square yards of 4 inch concrete sidewalk; 445 square yards of 6 inch sidewalk; 120 linear feet gutter plate supports; and 20 gutter plates.

Plans, specifications and form of contract documents may be examined at the office of the City Engineer and at the office of the City Clerk, City Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho and a set of plans, specifications and forms may be obtained at the offices of either of the above upon deposit of \$10.00 payable to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

The full amount of the deposit for one set of documents will be returned to each actual bidder within a reasonable time after receipt of bids. Other deposits will be refunded with deduction not to exceed the actual cost of reproduction of the drawings, upon the return of all documents in good condition within 30 days after the date of opening bids.

All bidders shall designate the locality, quarry, kiln or factory from which will be furnished the specific material to be used by them, with its commercial designation.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check made payable to the City of Idaho Falls, in the amount not less than 5% of the amount bid.

The City of Idaho Falls, Idaho reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive informalities.

No bidder may withdraw his bid after the hour set for opening thereof, or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding 30 days.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Fire Chief be instructed to condemn the chimney in the K.I.D. Building, and notify the owner not to make any more fires in the furnace before the chimney is repaired. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Airport Agreement with the Western Airlines, Inc., covering lease at the Municipal Airport from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1946, to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1950 was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
