The Mayor referred the Petition to the Fire Committee and the Fire Chief.  
The following Petition signed by 125 citizens and taxpayers was read:

Henry Pincock, resident in the Eighteenth Street vicinity, read a Petition bearing the names of 125 signers asking the Council to withdraw a building permit of Floyd S. Heyrend for the construction of a \$6500 building for the manufacture of millwork on West Eighteenth Street.

Mr. Pincock told the Council that the signers object to that kind of industrial plant being established in that area.

Mayor Fanning informed Mr. Pincock that the land on which Mr. Heyrend was planning to construct his building was in the industrial zone where such an industry would be permitted. He said the Council could take no action except to refer the matter to the Board of Adjustment. He pointed out that residents in that area had been allowed to protest their being included in the industrial zone at the time the Zoning Ordinance was created.

The Mayor referred the petition to the Board of Appeals.

The Mayor appointed the following Patrolmen to the Police Department: Kenneth L. North, Robert D. Pollock, Joseph A. King, Ray Metcalf. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the appointments be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Voting Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the appointments be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed Morgan Parks as a member of the Fire Department. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor made the following appointments for a three year term on the Library Board: Mrs. J. J. Smith; Lynn Crandall. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the appointments be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
