

APRIL 19, 1946

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 19th, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for licenses were read: Master Plumber, Earl Harris, Jr.; Journeyman Plumber, Verl A. Bair.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 581 of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, provides, among other things, for the creation and establishment of an area designated as a parking meter zone within the corporate limits of the City of Idaho Falls, and authorizes and directs The Chief of Police of said City to designate such streets and parts of streets and loading spaces to be included within such zone as may be deemed proper and necessary for the control of traffic, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City of Idaho Falls, pursuant to the aforesaid Ordinance, has designated the following streets and parts of streets to be included within the parking meter zone of the City of Idaho Falls, to wit:

Capital Avenue from the South side of "B" Street on the North to the North side of Market Street on the South;

Park Avenue from the South side of "C" Street on the North to the North side of Market Street on the South;

Shoup Avenue from the South side of "C" Street on the North to the North side of Market Street on the South;

"B" Street from the West side of Cottage Avenue on the East to the East side of Capital Avenue on the West;

"A" Street from the West side of Cottage Avenue on the East to the East side of Capital Avenue on the West;

Broadway from the West side of Cottage Avenue on the East to the East side of Capital Avenue on the West;

"C" Street from a point near the West side of Park Avenue West along the South side of "C" Street to the driveway running North and South along the West line of the United States Federal Building property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the aforesaid designation of the streets and parts of streets by the Chief of Police of the City of Idaho Falls to be included within the parking meter zone of the City of Idaho Falls, be, and the same is hereby approved, by the Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Voting Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

Honorable E. W. Fanning
Mayor, City of Idaho Falls
Idaho Falls, Idaho

Dear Mayor Fanning,

It is increasingly evident from day to day that the traffic over Idaho highways during the coming season will be far in excess of any that has been experienced prior to this time, and, therefore, all existing bottle-necks which retard the proper operation of highway traffic should be eliminated or rather the inconvenience should be minimized as much as possible.

There is presently existing an Ordinance, passed by the City of Idaho Falls, prohibiting parking of vehicles on one side of Cottage Avenue in Idaho Falls, from the underpass southerly.

I would not only suggest the enforcement of this regulation, but specifically request, in the interest of all highway users, that the Ordinance be made to apply to both sides of the highway in question.

Would you please advise, at your earliest convenience, as to your reaction of the contents of this letter for I beg to assure you that it will not be the policy of this Department in any way to make any town subject to disagreeable or unjust criticism.
