

APRIL 11, 1946

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 5th, 1946, and recessed until April 11th, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; when the following proceedings were had, to wit:

An Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND SETTING FORTH THE BOUNDARIES OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 19 IN AND FOR IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF GRADING, GRAVELING, PRIME-COATING, TACK-COATING, PAVING, CURBING, GUTTERING, SURFACE DRAINING AND CONSTRUCTION SIDEWALKS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND PARTS OF STREETS, ALLEYS AND PARTS OF ALLEYS THEREIN; PROVIDING THAT SUCH IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE MADE AND THAT THE COST AND EXPENSE OF SUCH IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE TAXED AND ASSESSED UPON ALL PROPERTY IN SAID DISTRICT IN PROPORTION TO THE NUMBER OF SQUARE FEET OF LANDS AND LOTS ABUTTING, ADJOINING, CONTIGUOUS AND ADJACENT THERETO INCLUDED IN SAID DISTRICT AND IN PROPORTION TO THE BENEFITS DERIVED TO SUCH PROPERTY BY SAID IMPROVEMENTS, AND PROVING THAT THE WHOLE COST AND EXPENSE OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN STREET INTERSECTIONS AND ALLEY INTERSECTIONS SHALL BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FURTHER THAT THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS IS DEPENDENT UPON THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS TO DEFRAY THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS OTHER THAN THE COST AND EXPENSE TO BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE CITY," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk and it was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 584 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following bids to paint Highland Baseball grandstand, bleachers, fence and rooms were opened and read:

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the bid of Colson Sign Service of \$1703.50 be accepted, and the contract be awarded to Colson Sign Service. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Applications for license to operate five coin operated amusement device machines signed by the Veterans Club was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Voting Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
