APRIL 5, 1946

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49 Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated March 13, 1946, recorded in Book 52 of Deeds at Page 201, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of Lots 40 and 41 in Block 20 South Park Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, DE LOY ROWBURY, of Burley, Idaho, has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said DE LOY ROWBURY for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

An agreement with Edward L. Burton Corporation covering the bond issue for Special Improvement District No. 19 was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City Clerk be authorized to advertise a call for bids to paint the Highland Park grandstand, bleachers, fences, and all office rooms, and dressing rooms. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase a 1½ ton truck with a dump bed for the Street Department. The truck to cost \$2,314.32 F.O.B. Idaho Falls. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following written protests against Special Improvement District No. 19 were read: Independent School District No. 1, Anton Ernest, Ann B. Cox, Ethel M. Bray, Ross K. McCafferty, Leland Howard.

The following property owners appeared before the City Council to protest against the paving of streets in front of their lots: Sol R. Harris, Frank Walsron, Mrs. A. B. Johnson, D. E. Hanson, Lester Beck, Carl Gould and Acey Vest.

Against sidewalks-----Douglass Cook, Dr. John Kimball. The protests were taken under advisement by the City Council.
