

FEBRUARY 19, 1946

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held February 15th, 1946 and recessed until February 19th, 1946.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Freeman; when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

Ben E. Miller requests the City to close four feet of Poulson Street on the south side of his property so that he can build on a straight line with the other buildings on this street.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the City Attorney be instructed to draw up an Ordinance to close four feet of Poulson Street for Ben E. Miller. Mr. Miller agrees to pay the cost of publishing the Ordinance. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Request of L. E. Malmberg to have the City close the alley and street north and west of his property at 105 First Street, which was referred to the Street Committee for investigation.

The Street Committee recommends that the request be rejected. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the recommendation of the Street Committee be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE PLAT AND DEDICATION OF STREETS AND ALLEYS IN THE WEST BROADWAY ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 579 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An Ordinance entitled, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, AND THE TRAFFIC THEREON, WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO; PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLMENT, REGULATION, CONTROL AND THE USE OF PARKING METERS; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING METER

ZONES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO
FALLS, IDAHO, AND PRESCRIBING THE RIGHTS OF THE OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF

FEBRUARY 19, 1946

WITHIN SAID ZONES; PRESCRIBING THE LIMITS OF TIME FOR PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES AND FOR THE DEPOSIT OF COINS WITHIN THE PARKING METERS; PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT AND FOR THE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that all the bids for a deep well pump for the Central Park well be rejected, and the checks to cover five percent of the bids be returned to the bidders. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor, City Engineer and Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase a suitable pump for the Central Park well. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Service Agreement between the Utah Power & Light Company and the City of Idaho Falls, covering the sale and purchase of Electrical power was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
