RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls is the owner of the following property:

Beginning at a point that is South 50° 44' West 367.7 feet from the meander corner on the West bank of the Snake River and on the section line that is common to Sections 13 and 24, Township 2 North, Range 37 East Boise Meridian, said point of beginning being in the West property line of River Parkway of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and running thence North 64° 39' West 153.4 feet to the East bank of the Porter Canal, thence Northerly 965 feet along the East bank of the Porter Canal, to the intersection of said East bank of the Porter Canal and the West property line of River Parkway to the point of beginning.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, AND THE TRAFFIC THEREON, WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO: PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLMENT, REGULATION, CONTROL AND THE USE OF PARKING METERS: PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING METER ZONES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PRESCRIBING THE RIGHTS OF THE OWNERS OR OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN SAID ZONES; PRESCRIBING THE LIMITS OF TIME FOR PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES AND FOR THE DEPOSIT OF COINS WITHIN THE PARKING METERS: PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT AND FOR THE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor stated that Worth D. Wright had resigned as a member of the City Planning Commission, and the Mayor appointed A. W. Brunt to fill the vacancy. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the resignation be accepted, and the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor stated that Freeman Hansen had resigned as a member of the Plumbers Examining Board, and the Mayor appointed Lambert Leaverton to fill the vacancy. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the resignation be accepted, and the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
