It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that permission be granted to install scales in alley between Bonneville Co-op and the Modern Cabins. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 576, AND PROVIDING THAT THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF TWELVE MEMBERS was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on it’s first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 578 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and

was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the City purchase twenty acres of land from Carl E. Johnson for \$15,000.00, Blocks 33, 34, 38, and 39 in South Idaho Falls Addition. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the City make application for 150 housing units, and mail same to the Federal Housing Authority, Seattle, Washington. These housing units are to be used by World War II Veterans. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting recess until January 25th, 1946, at 8 o'clock P.M. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 8th day of February, 1946.
