

DECEMBER 21, 1945

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held December 21st, 1945.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following bids for a street sweeper were opened and read:

Western Machinery Co.	Bid \$4,496.32
Nelson Equipment Co.	Bid 3,900.00
Intermountain Equipment Co.	Bid 7,465.00

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the bid of Western Machinery Company of \$4,496.32 be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION TO CONSIST OF SEVEN MEMBERS FOR THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on it's third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None. The Ordinance was then numbered 576 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed, and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING SPECIFICATIONS FOR ELECTRIC WATER TANK HEATERS AND ELECTRICALLY HEATED WATER TANKS WHICH MAY BE HEREAFTER INSTALLED IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO: PROVIDING THAT ANY VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE SHALL BE A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 577 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for widow's allowance on water and light account signed by Annie Stevens was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed Alfred J. Pouch as Manager of the Municipal Airport. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Applications for license to operate coin-operated amusement device machines signed by F. O. Eagles, Inc., Idaho Falls, Aerie No. 576, and Blue Bird Club, Inc., were read. It was moved by Sutton, **DECEMBER 21, 1945**

seconded by Crabtree, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
