Application to operate two Taxicabs signed by the Deluxe Cab Co. was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the license be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled AN ORDINANCE CREATING A CITY PLANNING COMMISSION TO CONSIST OF SEVEN MEMBERS FOR THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING SPECIFICATIONS FOR ELECTRIC WATER TANK HEATERS AND ELECTRICITY HEATED WATER TANKS WHICH MAY BE HEREAFTER INSTALLED IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO; PROVIDING THAT ANY VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE SHALL BE A CRIMINAL

OFFENSE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its DECEMBER 7, 1945

second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 AND SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 552 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING THAT THE IDAHO FALLS MOTOR COACH CO., INC. SHALL FILE WITH THE CITY CLERK A PUBLIC LIABILITY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE POLICY AND FIXING THE AMOUNT THEREOF; AND PROVIDING THAT THE IDAHO FALLS MOTOR COACH CO., INC. SHALL, AFTER JANUARY 1, 1951, PAY TO THE CITY ONE PER CENT OF ITS GROSS INCOME AS A ROYALTY was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman. The Ordinance was then numbered 575 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase two garbage beds at \$1,480.00 each for the Sanitary Department. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Purchasing Agent write to Manufacturers for quotations on a Street Sweeper for the Street Department. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Absent: Freeman. The Meeting was adjourned.
